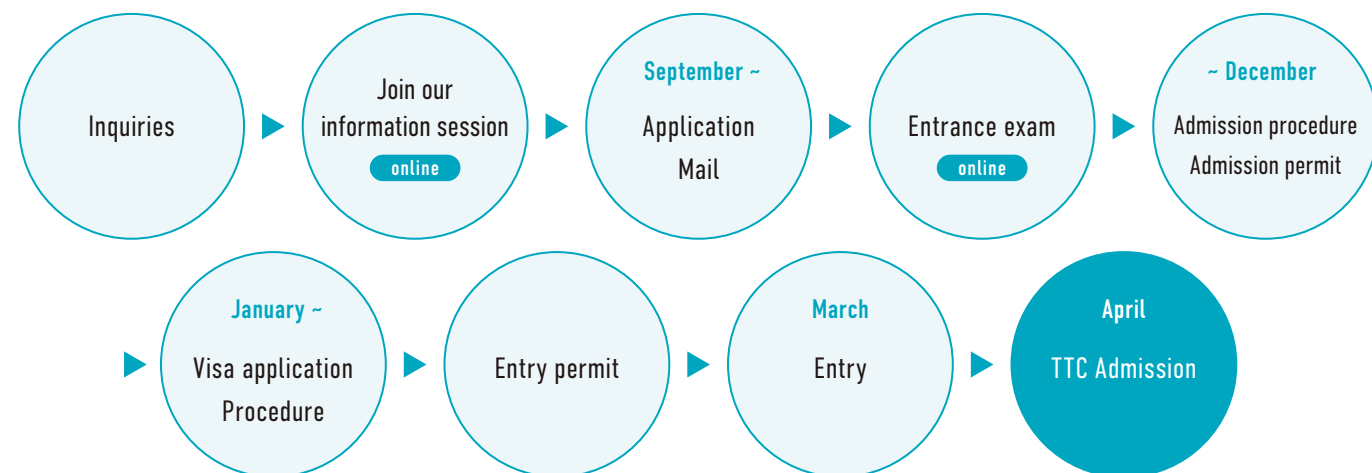


Flow of admission



Scholarships, tuition exemptions, support, and referral systems for international students

1 Benefits for international students recommended by specified schools

This is a system for reducing or exempting tuition fees for applicants recommended by specified schools who have excellent grades and attendance.

2 Scholarships for international students

This is a system reducing or exempting the cost of tuition fees for applicants who have excellent grades and attendance.

3 Koyama Gakuen Supporters' Association Scholarships

The Koyama Gakuen Supporters' Association, which consists of 116 outstanding companies, offers grant-type scholarships.

4 (for international students) Koyama Gakuen Supporters' Association Scholarships for Higher Education

These scholarships are offered by the Koyama Gakuen Supporters' Association to students who wish to pursue a higher level of specialized education.

5 Koyama Gakuen Honor Students Program

This is an independent system by Koyama Gakuen that provides partial exemption from tuition fees for currently enrolled students.

6 Student Dormitory Support Program

To help alleviate the financial burden on prospective students, partial support is provided for the cost of living in designated Koyama Gakuen student dormitories.

7 Referral Systems

There is a referral system for current students and graduates, a referral system for faculty and staff, and a referral system for supporting companies, and a Harley-Davidson referral system.

There are many other scholarships available for international students.

▶ Orientation for international students

In April, prior to the start of classes, an orientation is held for international students, where we explain in detail how we support international students at our school in their studies and in daily living.

▶ International Student Consultation Service

Staff responsible for international students are available to help with any problems that international students may experience in their studies or in daily living.

▶ Employment counseling

We provide specialized job-seeking guidance to international students who wish to find a job in Japan, supporting their efforts to find a job at outstanding companies.

▶ Accident insurance

We provide accident insurance for students against accidents or injuries that may occur during classes, practical training, school events, extracurricular activities, or in daily life while students are enrolled in our school.

▶ Accommodation referrals

We will introduce you to student dormitories and real estate agencies affiliated with our school.

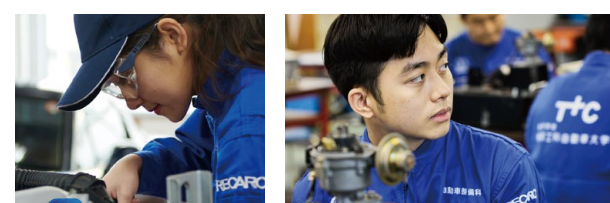
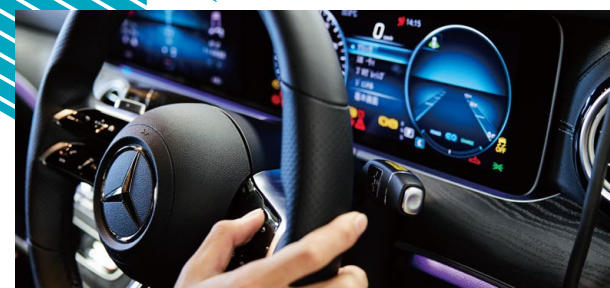

If you wish to work as a professional mechanic in the automotive industry, you need either a first-class or second-class certification. By enrolling in a vocational school, you can obtain a second-class certification in as little as 2 years and start working in Japan.

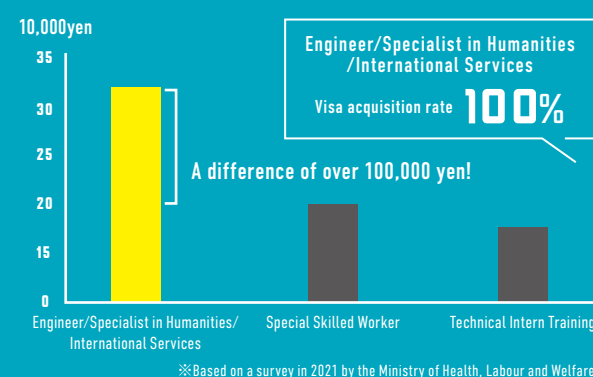

Compared to "Specified Skilled Worker" or "Technical Intern Training" work visas, where salaries are below 200,000 yen per month, you can earn over 100,000 yen more!
